

Pine Bluff Gun Club Minutes from June 5, 2022

The meeting called to order at 2:00 PM at the White Hall Community Center.

Opened with a prayer and pledge.

The financial and membership reports were presented and approved by the members present. There are a few openings if you know of anyone interested.

Match Director reports given next. Check the website for times, changes, cancellations, etc. Will be under Venues. [pbgunclub.org](http://pbgunclub.org).

Defensive Pistol Match – held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month starting at 9:00 AM with entry fee of \$5.00. Open to both members and the public. Usually around 75 to 90 rounds. Good training and trigger time. Is a fun match. Appropriate for all levels of shooters from novice to expert.

Bowling Pin Match – held the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month except for December and January. The standard match is 4 rimfire pins taken off followed by 5 centerfire pins knocked off (is a pistol match, not rifle). March, June and September incorporate an array of 20 or so steel targets as well. Will shoot 3 strings if time permits. Entry fee of \$5.00. Open to the members and the public. Lots of fun and challenging.

Youth Shooting Sports – still have the kids shooting shotguns.

Old Business reviewed.

The A500 steel targets of varying sizes are in. In the process of fabricating a mount for them. Should be up soon. Will be at 200 and 300 yards. No armor piercing rounds or steel core ammunition (if your ammunition attaches to a magnet it is steel core).

The new gate will be up soon. Posts are set. He hopes to have the gate and entryway done this month.

Due to various factors, we as a club need to take over the building of the shotgun trap range. Volunteers are being asked for to oversee this. The money is there. Just need to get the various contractors arranged and the project done. Let the Officers or Trustees know if you can help.

There is still an issue with destruction of props and target stands. Do not shoot the barrels as those are used in the Defensive Pistol Matches. The PVC target stand holders keep turning up missing or shot up. This needs to stop.

New Business:

Dues are payable yearly by midnight June 30<sup>th</sup>. If you have not paid, do so immediately. There is an online option at the web site to pay via PayPal if desired.

The next meeting date will be January 15, 2023 at the White Hall Community Center at 2:00 PM.
